## Saturday, 23 May 2015


Arrive in Saint-Tropez, France by noon.

Nestled along the French Riviera, St. Tropez is one of the liveliest towns along the coast. Delight in the sandy beaches, culture, gourmet food and hot nightlife of St. Tropez. ## Sunday 24 May 2015

8:30AM arrive and tender at the harbor in Monte-Carlo, Monaco. Your ship's tender boat will be on continuous service to the dock by your preferred T Grandstand seats. This grandstand is ideally located in the Monaco Harbour, in front of the pit-lane, with a direct view on the team's garages. This is the grandstand where sponsors and Paddock Club guests also watch the race. It also enjoys a view of the straight section after the exit of the last right / left "S" of the Swimming Pool Complex. Its location opposite the pits, also places you in the heat of the action, with a view of the mechanics at work during and after the race. The big screen opposite this grandstand intensifies the drama and magnifies the racing action on other parts of the circuit. Your seat are also covered to protect you from the sun and reserved so you can come and go as you please.



After the race enjoy free time in Monte Carlo as your ship does not sail until 1:00AM on Monday, Morning.

## Monday 25 May 2015

Cannes, France

Morning arrive in Cannes, the "star" of the French Riviera, famous for the International Film Festival and the glitzy hotels, cars, beaches and visitors attracted here. The city of Cannes is centered around the old port, with the central part quite compact. The famous "Croisette" is the boulevard and the beach that extends around the bay to the east of the port, in the protected "Rade de Cannes".



As the 2015 Cannes Film Festival just ended on Sunday you still may see actors, celebrities, and directors up close and in person on the famous steps of the Palais des Festivals at the end of La Croisette. Although its

nightlife, casinos and high end restaurants give Cannes a feel of exclusivity, Cannes does have alternatives to suit all interests. You can also check out the beauty and architecture of Le Suquet, with its cobbled streets and breathtaking views, or sit at street side tables and enjoy the favoured hobby of people watching up and down the lovely marina.



### Tuesday 26 May 2015

Early morning arrive back in Nice. Here you will "bid adieu" to your ship and crew and be transferred to the Nice Airport for your flight back home.
