Fairbanks: The Heart of the Interior

College Fjord!

Some of the best glacier viewing in the state can be seen at *College Fjord*. Tucked into the northwest corner of Prince William Sound, this fjord boasts the world's largest collection of tidewater glaciers - sixteen of them, named after Ivy League college by the Harriman Expedition that discovered them in 1899.

Skagway

This port of call is the gold rush town of *Skagway*. You can still catch the Gold Rush fever as you tour historic Skagway. From the wooden boardwalks and false-fronted buildings to the horsedrawn wagons and townsfolk in period costume.

Juneau

A walk through downtown *Juneau* will take you past turn-of-the-century residences, museums packed with gold rush history, rustic frontier saloons and hotels, and bustling shops. For adventure, pick from an array of optional excursions including flightseeing over the Ice Fields and rafting on the Mendenhall River. Alaska boasts one of the largest concentrations of wildlife in the northern hemisphere. Juneau is known for Harbor Seals, Bald Eagles and Mountain Goats.

Ketchikan

Built on the site of a Tlingit fishing camp, *Ketchikan*, has the highest concentration of Native Alaskans than any other city in the state. The name Ketchikan is said to mean "Eagle River" in Tlingit, which describes the tumbling waterfalls on Ketchikan Creek. The world's largest collection of totem poles can be found at Saxman Village.
