


01 February 2013

Transfer to the Cleveland Airport. (Other Airports are available) Depart on your overnight flights to exciting South Africa. Meals and movies on the flights. (CLE-IAD, IAD-JNB, JNB-CPT)

02 February 2013

On arrival at Cape Town International, you will be met by your local guide for assistance on our transfer to and check-in at the hotel. * We did not include dinners at the hotel as the costs for a group dinner was not a good value. All the hotels have dining choices and hotels in Cape Town and Johannesburg have other options within walking distance. A full breakfast is included each day along with some fun local lunches. All meals are included at the Game Lodge.

Stylishly grand and perfectly majestic, Southern Sun, The Cullinan offers guests easy access to most of Cape Town's exclusive business and leisure venues. 03 February 2013

After breakfast, you will be met by the guide for a full day Cape Peninsula Tour, beginning by traveling along the Atlantic Seaboard past Clifton to Hout Bay and experience a cruise past the seals on Seal Island, continue over Chapman's Peak to the Cape Point Nature Reserve.

Enjoy a lunch at a local fish restaurant (included) before paying a visit to the penguins on Boulders Beach and Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.

You may want to visit the famous "Victoria & Alfred Waterfront Complex" a British themed entertainment and dining destination that is also a working dock. www.waterfront.co.za

04 February 2013

After breakfast at the hotel, you will be met by the guide for the transfer to the ferry departure point for Robben Island, a World Heritage Site. The island became infamous during South Africa's years under Apartheid rule. The government banished dissidents and political prisoners to the island, the most famous one being former president, Nelson Mandela.

In the afternoon you will visit Table Mountain, one of Cape Town's iconic landmarks.

05 February 2013

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airport to board the flight to the Great Kruger National Park area. On arrival, you will be met by the local driver for the transfer to the lodge. (CPT-HDS)

At the lodge you will be met and shown to your rooms. After settling in, enjoy lunch. Set on the banks of a tranquil lake, with breathtaking views of the African bush. The lodge offers a thrilling array of gaming activities in this vast reserve, from open safari game drives, to bush walks and birding trips.

The facilities include a rim-flow swimming pool with wooden sun deck. The lounge is an ideal place to retreat from the mid-day sun. Meals are served in the Rhino Boma dining room.

Each of the spacious suites is equipped air-conditioning, fans, telephone, tea/coffee making facilities, mini bar, safe, hairdryer and terrace/balcony.

After lunch there is free time to relax during the heat of the day. All guests will congregate in the late afternoon for British high tea before embarking on your first open vehicle game drive under the guidance of your experienced ranger and tracker team in search of Africa's famous wildlife.

At sunset stop for sundowners to toast the end of another awesome day in South Africa, before continuing the safari after dark with the aid of powerful spotlights to, hopefully, glimpse some of the elusive nocturnal game. Return to the lodge for a wonderful dinner.

The exclusive Kapama River Lodge offers unique exclusive Safari experiences in both open Land Rovers, and on foot. The Kapama Game Reserve is in Limpopo Province, an area renowned for superb safari vacations. Kapama's 13000 hectares has all the big game of Africa with 42 mammal species and approximately 350 bird species. This equates to huge natural diversity and includes the famed 'Big 5' - lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino. 06 February 2013

Enjoy the full day on safari.

Your twice daily safaris take place at dawn and dusk, when the bush is at its most active and chances of spotting game the best.

Your experience ranger and tracker team will help you make the most of your time on safari through their extensive knowledge of the African savannah. The reserve is home to a wide variety of African game, including the "Big Five" lion, elephant, rhino, leopard and buffalo.

07 February 2013

The day starts as dawn breaks over the African bushveld. After your early morning wakeup call, coffee, tea & rusks are served on the main deck overlooking the riverbed. Shortly after, you depart in your open Range Rover with your experienced Rangers and Trackers who will share their extensive knowledge of the bush with you. These drives are undertaken at times best suited for game viewing which vary depending on the season but typically start early morning. Where applicable you may be invited out of the vehicle to see tracks and examine certain plants.

After an exhilarating hunt for tracks to see what the animals have been up to during the night, and tracking down whatever you find, you will stop somewhere out in the bush for a break of coffee & tea. Time to stretch your legs whilst having your sunglasses cleaned & indulge in cool towels. After a sumptuous Breakfast is served either back at the camp or in the riverbed or bush, guests are offered walks to suit their interests and fitness levels and are accompanied by an armed ranger.

The Shangaan trackers will enthral you with their explanations of the medicinal and other uses of the numerous plants and trees along with tales of traditional folklore.

The rest of the day is spent at the discretion of the guest for other activities that we offer, with a delicious lunch being served around 1.30pm.

The afternoon game drive is preceded by high tea and extends into the evening to view seldom seen nocturnal species by torchlight.

Upon returning for a gourmet 3 course dinner, either in the boma, bush or lodge - guests can socialize with a cognac, single malt or cigar around the campfire or lounge before returning to bed for another day's adventure.

08 February 2013

Awake early for a final morning safari in this unspoiled wilderness, and a last chance to maybe spot that elusive leopard! Return to the lodge for a hearty breakfast before the transfer to the Airport to board the flight to Johannesburg. (HDS-JMB)

Jo'Burg was an important part of the British Empire.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant (included) before a tour of the Apartheid Museum. Return to the hotel in the late afternoon, free evening.

10 February 2013

After breakfast, you will be met by the guide for the transfer to the airport to board the flight to Victoria Falls Airport. (JNB-VFA or LVI)

On arrival, you will be met by your guide for the transfer to the hotel. Enjoy time at leisure until you are met by the guide in the late afternoon for a Sundowner Cruise on the mighty Zambezi River.

The famous Victoria Falls Hotel is one hotel which can truly claim to be unique. For almost 100 years, visiting members of Royal families, international and local statesmen, and celebrities worldwide have stayed at the hotel. This hotel boasts an atmosphere steeped in history, combining the charm of the old with the comfort and convenience of today.
