You'll call on three of Alaska's most charming towns - Skagway, Juneau and Ketchikan. Now that you've seen the best from the water, you'll go inland to see the rugged landscape Alaska is famous for with 2 nights in Denali, 2 nights in Mt. McKinley and 1 night in Anchorage.

Saturday, June 13 - Vancouver

Arrival in Vancouver to board your ship, the Star Princess for the start of your Alaskan adventure.

Sunday, June 14 - Inside Passage

Enjoy a full day of scenic cruising. Watch for wildlife along the sheltered waters of the Inside Passage.

Monday, June 15 - Ketchikan

Built on the site of a Tlingit fishing camp, Ketchikan, has the highest concentration of Native Alaskans than any other city in the state. The name Ketchikan is said to mean "Eagle River" in Tlingit, which describes the tumbling waterfalls on Ketchikan Creek. The world's largest collection of totem poles can be found at Saxman Village.

Tuesday, June 16 - Juneau

In Juneau, the charming state capitol, you'll find shops, cafes and the storied Red Dog Saloon. Today it is famous not only for gold and government but also for its breathtaking beautiful glaciers and stunning views of both water and mountains. Just outside town is the famous urban Mendenhall Glacier.

Wednesday, June 17 - Skagway

Rustic Skagway retains its authenticity as the "Gateway to the Yukon", where thousands flocked to Alaska in the hope of striking it rich. The town offers attractions such as a ride on a Gold Rush-era railroad and lovely restored storefronts, wooden sidewalks and local characters.

Thursday, June 18 - Glacier Bay/Scenic Cruising

The icy wilderness of this spectacular national park and preserve of Glacier Bay, is where you'll experience the mystical world of glaciers and floating ice castles. Nothing can prepare you for the sight and sound-towering rivers of crystal blue ice, at one moment silent and majestic, the next loudly shedding of massive icebergs into the sea below. The National Park Service Rangers come onboard in Glacier Bay to educate you about the spectacular sights you'll see in this National Park and Preserve. Onboard lectures from naturalists shed light on Alaska's history, wildlife and environment.

Friday, June 19 - College Fjord

Enjoy a day of scenic cruising. Have a great day of sailing as you explore the Star Princess and enjoy all the amenities aboard the ship. You can just sit back and watch the fabulous views from the deck. Today is yours to enjoy at your leisure. This evening you'll be cruising College Fjord with glacier viewing of 16 Glaciers.



Saturday, June 20 - Whittier/Denali

Board your Princess Rail for a ride through the historic route of the Alaskan Railroad for Denali National Park. You'll arrive at Denali Princess Lodge for a 2-night stay.

Sunday, June 21 - Denali

Today's highlight is a Natural History tour into the Park, introducing you to its plants, animals and geography. Later you'll have free time to choose from optional excursions or just relax. Tonight you may wish to make reservations at the optional "Music of Denali Dinner Theater".

Monday, June 22 - Denali/Mt. McKinley

Today you'll travel by motorcoach for a 2 night stay at the Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge, where the views are nothing short of inspiring.

Tuesday, June 23 - Mt. McKinley

Today you have a full day of leisure to spend as you choose. Visit the Tour Desk for ideas from fishing to flightseeing. Or you might prefer to explore the natural trails at the lodge and take in the sweeping vistas around you.

Wednesday, June 24 - Mt. McKinley/Anchorage

Today we will motorcoach to the cosmopolitan city of Anchorage, set in the shadows of the beautiful Chugach Mountains. This evening you will be staying at Hotel Captain Cook. You will have the afternoon and night at your leisure to explore this delightful town on your own.
